

## **FIRST NOTICE of ELECTION (1, 2 and 5)**

Notice of Supervisor Election for the Edgewood Soil and Water Conservation District  
(73-20-49 NMSA 1978).

To all registered voters situated within the Edgewood Soil and Water Conservation District, counties of Bernalillo, Santa Fe, and Tarrant, State of New Mexico.

Notice is hereby given that on the 1st Tuesday of May, 2010, between the hours of 7 AM and 7 PM. Polls will be open to elect three supervisors of the Edgewood Soil and Water Conservation District, in accordance with the New Mexico Soil and Water Conservation District Act.

The positions to be filled are position # 1 currently being filled by Lewis Fisher, position # 2 currently being filled by Mark Anaya and position # 5 currently held by Josephine Bassett. Positions 1 and 2 may only be filled by resident owners of land within the district. Position 5 must be filled by a resident of the district.

Declarations of candidacy may be obtained beginning on March 8, 2010 until March 12, 2010, at 2506 Route 66, Moriarty, NM 87035, between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM. Declarations of candidacy must be filed at the above address on March 16, 2010 between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM. Write in candidates must file declarations of candidacy on March 23, 2010 at the above address between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM.

Eligible voters within the district shall obtain and cast their ballots at the polling place on the day of the election; OR

Eligible voters who will be absent on the day of the election may request an absentee ballot application by mail, by phone, and in person. Absentee ballot applications will be available between April 4, 2010 and April 14, 2010 between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM at:
