- Building renovation and improvement project (\$100,000) which includes:
  - \$50,000 ~ Solar energy array to reduce our operating costs and provide a highly visible demonstration project in the region
  - \$10,000 ~ Security gate with keypad
  - \$10,000 ~ Repaying and striping of parking lot
  - \$30,000 ~ Construction of covered breezeway
- o Purchase of vehicle (\$30,000)
  - \$30,000 ~ New 2019 or 2020 Sedan to replace existing high mileage vehicle

Of the requests, the only one awarded was \$15,000 towards the purchase of a vehicle.
